Application Fees	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> General Application Fee (mandatory for all applicants)..... \$185 Academic Equivalency Assessment Fee (for applicants who have completed non-accredited academic and practical training programs)..... \$300 Practical Training Assessment Fee (for applicants who have completed non-accredited and self-directed practical training, outside of a formal program)..... \$300 Upgrading Assessment Fee (for applicants who completed their education and training more than 3 years ago, and who have not been practising dietetics as a member of a regulatory body in the past 3 years)..... \$300 	
Temporary Membership Fee (optional)	\$100
Exam Fees <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exam Registration Fee (mandatory for all applicants) Alternate Site Fee (optional - for those who wish to write the exam outside of Toronto or Ottawa) 	\$400 Fee varies based on the cost of booking a room and invigilator for the exam. The College will advise the final amount of the alternate site fee once the total cost has been determined.
Transcripts Applicants are responsible for arranging to have original transcripts sent directly from their university to the College.	Costs vary. Consult with your university.

Assessment of the Academic level of degree. If your degree was completed outside of Canada or the US, you must have the degree assessed through the World Education Service (WES). This service will determine whether your degree(s) is equivalent in level to an undergraduate degree in Canada. Translation You are responsible to arrange for the translation of any documents that are not in English or French.	Cost will vary depending on the volume of text that must be translated.
